

## **HOSTEL GUIDELINES FOR UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION- SEP 2020**

In the context outlined above, It is hereby informed to all the students that:

1. The University Examinations for B.Tech. VIII Semester and MBA IV semester will commence from 21 September 2020 as per RTU notification <http://www.rtu.ac.in/home/b-tech/> and <http://www.rtu.ac.in/home/mba/>
2. That the hostel will be open from 14th September 2020 and mess will be started from evening of 16<sup>th</sup> September 2020.
3. That all the students who wish to avail the hostel facility, for the duration of examination should contact for the same to Mr. Mukesh Samota, Mobile : 9251304081 and email on [warden@rietjaipur.ac.in](mailto:warden@rietjaipur.ac.in)

The advisories in view of COVID-19 are as follows:

1. The students shall not be allowed for movement outside the campus for any reason whatsoever. Thus, it is intimated to all students to come to the campus along-with all the books/ laptops / stationary / snacks/fruits/extra clothings/N-95 masks/sanitizers/ supplies etc. as no movement outside the campus will be permitted for the entire schedule of examination.
2. Students should bring good quality sanitizers, soaps with them which are sufficient for the duration of their stay in hostel.
3. In view of the pandemic and corresponding advisories, the allotted rooms to the students might be different from the one in which they were staying previously. In this regard, the decision of the management will be final.
4. Mess facility will be provided for complete duration of examination.
5. The students shall remain in their respective rooms expect for examination and mess hrs.
6. The students will not be allowed, at any place and at any time, without Mask.
7. Students shall follow the norms for social distancing, including maintaining distance, avoid touching common surfaces etc. as per WHO Covid-19 guidelines.
8. Any individual, who have been treated for COVID-19 will not be provided the hostel facilities.
9. All such students, who are suffering from common flu, throat infection, are advised not to avail the hostel facilities.
10. Students are required to bring the medical fitness certificate at the time of reporting .
11. The hostel will close on September 30, 2020 or after the end Term Theory and practical university examination.
