NOTICE DIRECTIONS REGARDING HOSTEL FACILITIES

It is evident to all of us that we all are facing unprecedented situations due to COVID-19, which emerged as the biggest catastrophe of the century. We have to face this challenge, in a way, so as to maintain our efforts towards studies, which protecting ourselves and our family/friends from this pandemic.

In this regard, we have to strictly follow the Guidelines of WHO, in accordance with the work-process which we need to follow, being an Institute of Higher and Technical Education.

The Board of Governors and Academic Council has a vision to transform the RIET Campus, into a purely residential campus, with all norms and measures followed as that prescribed by WHO, in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

In the aforesaid context, the guidelines regarding the hostel facilities are as follows:

- 1. From the current academic session, i.e. session 2021-22, the Board of Governors and Academic Council will recommend the Teaching Staff to avail the hostel facility.
- 2. New joining of the Faculty Members will also be made, preferring those candidates who avail the hostel facilities.
- 3. Those student who are outside of the Jaipur region, and currently staying in nearby 15 KM radius like outside Hostels, PG rooms, etc., are advised to avail the hostel facilities inside the campus.
- 4. Also, for the new admissions in the college in the academic session 2021-22, weightage will be given the students who will be availing the hostel facilities.
- 5. Also, in the hostels, the single seated rooms will be allotted primarily, as against double and triple seated rooms. Also, in Double/Triple Seater Rooms, the norms for social distancing, sanitization, etc., will be followed as per the guidelines issued for COVID-19.
- 6. All the staff and students in hostels will be allowed only for limited outings, and must follow sanitization, masking and social distancing related guidelines issued by WHO.
- 7. RIET campus has the BEST AIR AND WATER QUALITY INDEX. The same will be enhanced further by developing new Green Areas. Already, we have the lust green campus with largest ratio of green area as compared to all other technical Institutions like ours.
- 8. No hostel leaving applications are accepted during this period or upcoming session 2021-22, so hostler who have submitted their requests on mail or hardcopy are not considered as per the institute policy of covid-19 period.
- 9. All the Faculty / Staff / Students, residing in campus, need to go through regular medical checking, provided by the Management, and will be issued a certificate for



the same. The medical facilities shall be provided in the campus for all the campus residents.

10. Faculty and Students need to focus on the research areas and start-ups, in an environment, which is currently provided in only IITs where work in the laboratories is ongoing in 24X7 manner.

In this regard, cooperation from one and all is highly desirable
